Telltale Signs of Bed Bugs

Dark fecal spots, cast skins and smooshed bed bugs are signs of an infestation. If you find clusters (a lot of bites in one same area), they could be from bed bugs.

Attractants

Unfortunately, bed bugs don't discriminate. They will jump in your luggage, belongings and clothing no matter how clean you are.



Preventative Solutions

Mattress and box spring encasements are a wonderful way to protect your bed from bed bug infestations. Anything that is enclosed in the encasement's will be entombed and die. When traveling, make sure to inspect hotel rooms and furniture to prevent placing your belongings in rooms that could be infected. There are preventative sprays that can be used on luggage and belongings.
